


## Changing Logos App Pool Identity


## Step 1: Find the name of the administrator running the New World Services

Navigate to services and find the name of the user running the NWSAppService:



## Step 2: Change the LogosAppPool Identity to run as the user found in Step 1

- Navigate to your Application server and open Internet Information Services (IIS) manager.
- Expand the name of your machine in the left panel and select your Application Pools. You will need to change the Identity of the user running the LogosAppPool:





## Changing Logos App Pool Identity

- Right click the LogosAppPool and select Advanced Settings.
- Change the identity to the administrator account by clicking the browse button next to **ApplicationPoolIdentity** ..., selecting **Custom account:** and typing the user credentials.
