
eSuite Customization

To customize eSuite, you need to place some files in a Customization folder within each website. The example website used here is eUtilities.

In the location where your eSuite websites are installed, add a Customization folder for the website of each module.

Typically, the location is C:\Program Files\New World Systems\eSuite\Website\eSuite Module\Customization, where the eSuite module is a website, such as eSuite.Utilities. These files reside on the eSuite server:



Within this folder, place the following files provided by new world ERP:

- Stylesheet.css
- HeaderImage.jpg

Each module needs to point at the new header image within the Customization folder. To accomplish this task, open the file *stylesheet.css*. On the seventh line you will see a file path for the default header image. Change this path to point to the new header image you have located in the Customization folder:

Also, if you are comfortable changing the CSS of the page and would like to customize the color scheme of eSuite, you may do so within the CSS file. If problems occur in customizing the CSS file, delete the custom CSS file and reapply the file provided by new world ERP.
